<p>Literacy: Genre- Picture Books The children will read their books in groups of two to each other. They will then read them to the class individually. Finally, they will read their books to the kindergarten or first grade class. This assignment is based on how well they present their books. Expression, Eye contact, Volume of Voice, and Fluency.</p>
<p>English- Verb Forms pgs. 344 - 347 Simple Tenses- Present, Past, and Future- pgs. 348 - 351 Linking Verbs, pgs. 352 - 353. This will complete Part 2 of Verbs. Test on this part when we come back from Easter break. Probably that Wednesday.</p>
<p>Word Study- Proper Nouns- Words are from our Religion for the week. There are only fifteen words. Test is on Thursday, April 1.</p>
<p>Social Studies- We will finish up Lesson 5 - Federal Government- Why do we have a System of Checks and Balances? Hopefully start lesson 6-Limiting the Power of Government- Bill of Rights.</p>
<p>Religion- Discussing the Triduum, pgs. 367 - 368, 371 - 372. We will also be reading the passion in each of the four Gospels. No test this week.</p>
<p>Math- Chapter 11 Fractions Comparing fractions. Ordering Fractions from least to greatest and greatest to least.</p>
<p>Science- We are reviewing all Matter and Length and Volume and Measurement. Test is on Tuesday, March 30. The children are very familiar with the material.</p>
