Birthday Boxes for Baby Jesus

As we prepare to celebrate the birth of our Savior, Jesus, we are reminded of our own birthdays and how special they are. As a holiday service project the kindergartners will be putting together Birthday Boxes to be donated to the St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Mary's Church.

A Birthday Box is a disposable 13" x 9" foil pan which contains a cake mix, a can of frosting, a small jar of sprinkles and a package of candles. The pan is then covered with its plastic top and tied with ribbon and a bow. The St. Vincent de Paul Society will then share the boxes with those in need as they celebrate their child's birthday.

In order to coordinate our efforts I am asking for the following donations:

Girls:
