Dear Parents,

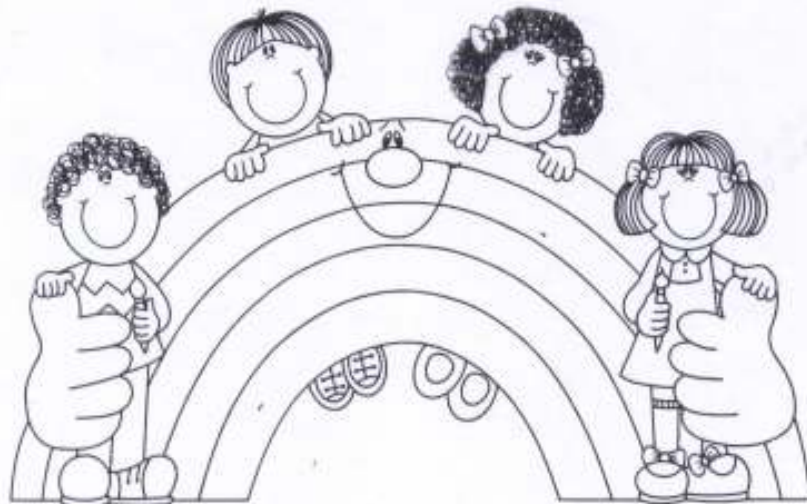
