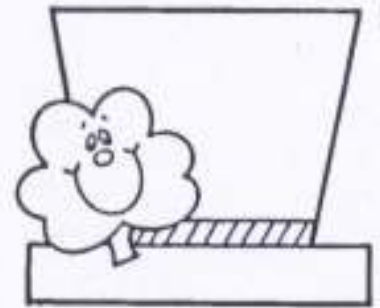


Kindergarten News
