At St. Mary's the preschool curriculum incorporates a variety of experiences in math, language, emergent literacy, movement, art and music to highlight a center-based program. Our preschool teachers provide exciting themes based on interests of the children to promote spiritual, social and emotional, language, and physical development. The children are exposed to the weekly Gospel. They are offered opportunities to understand the Word of the Lord through experience and environment, a seamless integration with the academic preschool curriculum. All instruction comes in the form of a warm, loving and accepting environment that celebrates our faith and the love of God.

Each week the children will experience the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd religious formation in a prepared environment in which every object is a help to knowing God; a place for community that assumes that since God is already present to them in their deepest being, they are capable of developing a conscience and intimate relationship with God.
